PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED, no charge.

Registration for Clean Up Day not needed.

Mora, East Central Solid Waste Facility
3 miles west of Mora at Hwy. 23 & 180th Ave (Co Rd 60). **Go west of Mora on Co. Rd. 6, south on Co. Rd. 12, east on 180th. (Vehicles will be prohibited from turning off Hwy 23 on 180th). Watch for signs.**

All of these items are recycled; components are re-used. *The focus is on recyclable materials.*

Appliances <i>Must be empty</i>	\$10 refrigerator, freezer, microwave, stove, dishwasher, disposal, washer, dryer, water heater, pumps, humidifier, furnace, air conditioner, etc.	\$12.00 water softener.
Tires	\$2 Car & smaller (acceptable with rims), less than 17" \$8 Over 17", pick up	\$25 Semi/Bobcat \$50 Tractor, skidster, off-road
TV	\$20 less than 20" \$30 20"-30" \$40 30" & larger, consoles	
Computers, Electronics Printer, DVD, scanner, etc	\$10 Per set (or parts of set, including monitor, hard drive, keyboard, laptop) \$8 Any small electronic item (DVD, printer, etc).	Commercial scanner/copier: \$35
Mattresses	\$20 Any size, mattresses and/or box springs. Must be dry.	
Fluorescent tubes, CFL & LED bulbs	NO charge for lights. <i>Must pre-register for Hazardous Waste collection, 320-679-6456</i>	
NO CHARGE	<p>* Scrap Metal: No 55 gal drums with lids. Some lawn mowers are re-built rather than scrapped. Propane tanks must be empty and vented. We CANNOT accept sealed drums.</p> <p>* cell batteries (car type). <i>Single use (AA, hearing aid, etc.) are garbage. Button & rechargeable batteries accepted by Arthur Township.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cell phones . Accept old cell phones and phone batteries. • Printer Ink accept ink cartridges. NEW!! 	

Recyclable materials: Tin, plastic, paper, glass, magazines, aluminum, corrugated cardboard. Please take here, no charge—NOT accepted at Clean Up Day:

- Arthur Town Hall (1899 Frontage Rd, 320-679-1347). Mon, Tues, Sat, 9-12; Wed, 9-5.

Garbage, Furniture: *Items go in the landfill.* Garbage goes over the scale, charged regular rates. Can be delivered any weekday or Sat. am.

We reserve the right to refuse items. Items refused—except for hazardous waste will be disposed of as garbage; owner pays fees as listed above. Owner must remove hazardous waste if not preregistered for the HHW collection.
