STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL CORNER WAS SET ON NOV. 12, 1855 BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR SILAS BARNARD AND 2 BEARING TREES NOTED AS:

10" YELLOW BIRCH @ 15 LINKS BEARING S44°W 12" BLACK ASH @ 25 LINKS BEARING EAST

NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE REMAINS TODAY FOR THE CORNER OR THE BEARING TREES.

THERE IS A ROAD OPENING ON FILE ALONG THE EAST LINE OF SEC. 30 DATED JULY 5, 1905 AND A SURVEY BY VICKERY WHO MEASURED THIS LINE TO BE 78.6 CHAINS OR 5187.6 FEET.

THE KANABEC COUNTY HWY DEPT RAN THIS LINE IN 1914 AND MEASURED IT TO BE 5221 FEET BUT NO TIES OR TYPE OF MONUMENTS WERE DOCUMENT IN THE NOTES.

TODAY WE MEASURE THIS LINE TO BE 5183.75 FEET. TESTIMONY FROM KEN MONSON (OWNER OF E1/2 OF SEC. 30) AND DAN WEBER (OWNER OF W1/2 OF SEC. 29) BOTH THOUGHT FENCE LINE IN PLACE WAS SECTION LINE. THIS CORNER WAS TREATED AS LOST AND SET ON LINE AND SPLIT BETWEEN THE NE AND SE CORNERS OF SEC. 30. THIS FELL 4 FEET WEST OF THE FENCE.

A $\#^{1}$ REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP WAS SET, TIES WERE TAKEN AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION.
