

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES

March 9, 2009

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, March 9, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Paul Kollar; Craig Peterson; Arlett Mizer; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink. A sign-in sheet was provided for those attending the meeting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said.

M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to approve the agenda. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the minutes of the February 9, 2009 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on February 28, 2009 of \$ 124,758.58. M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the claims.

BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR: none

**OLD BUSINESS:** Paul reported on two road projects. **Rip-Rap on 153<sup>rd</sup> Street** – Kelly of Kanabec SWCD office has plans ready and costs estimate for 400' is < or > \$ 39,700 with the potential of Snake River Watershed to pay 75% of the cost. Kelly to check with Dan Crowell or Pokegama Lake Assn. for additional \$'s for the project.

**Lumber Street** – Paul contacted D-O-Tea regarding the need for boring tests prior to shredded tires being placed and they said no need for boring tests. DNR supplied Paul with an application form and if work goes beyond width of road there may be a need for wetland credits. D-O-Tea will do the cat work for no more than \$ 3,000 – two feet of shredded tires – with there being no cost for the material. The Supervisors estimated the gravel and pit run cost to be about \$ 15,000 for 1900 feet.


M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to keep moving with applications for both projects – 153<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Lumber Street.

M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to appoint the following to the Planning Commission: Ed Beck for one year; Todd Steffen for one year; Richard Hall for two years; Dave DeVito for two years.

**NEW BUSINESS:** **Shanks culvert billing** – Clerk explained that the property where the culvert was placed is not recorded in Jeff Shanks name. M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to have the Clerk write a new letter to the owner of the property and table a decision on the matter to the April meeting.

Rick reported on the PC meeting at which there were recommended changes to the Zoning Ordinance. A Public Hearing on these proposed changes was set for April 13, 2009 at 6:30 p.m.

Board Chair recessed the meeting so the Supervisors could talk with employee, Susan. Rick reopened the meeting. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 pm.
