

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES
November 8, 2010

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, November 8, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Craig Peterson; Paul Kollar; Arlett Mizer; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink, absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said. A sign-in sheet was provided for all in attendance.

M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the agenda. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the minutes of the October 11, 2010 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on October 31, 2010 of \$ 79,612.72. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the claims.

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR: Ron Peterson expressed concern about the communication tower being built near Day. Ron relayed about 2 storms recently where power was out for an extended length of time and he questioned if the tower was being erected in the right spot? Was it too far from a substation? Are there backup generators in the building? The clerk was asked to refer these questions to Chris Caulk, Isanti County and ask for a response by the December meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: Mahogany Street project – KCR has worked class 5 to the grass and will do more widening of the road in the spring. Grass Lake wants rip rap by the culverts; however, it will plug the old culvert if put by new one as distance is too close.

Other road issues: 1) Chairman Kawalek signed the cost sharing forms for the rip-rap on the Groundhouse river project. 2) Lumber Street – some areas are getting shallow (top layer of class 5); M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to have the Clerk send a letter to Kadlec Excavating and ask them to build up the shallow areas and contact Paul Kollar for location details. 3) The driveway for Bronson Fix has been fixed. 4) There is still a dip in George Johnsen's driveway; Richard Hass said it will level out after a few grading trips.

NEW BUSINESS: Susan reported to the Clerk that she issued no land use permits and has not heard anything further from MN Pollution Control re: tire shreds on Niemi property.

Arlett reported that the invoice from D&M Excavating was to Kanabec Soil & Water; the Supervisors asked the Clerk to get a new one issued to the Town prior to releasing the check. Arlett asked if there were some major budget items to be considered for 2012 budget/levi. The ones mentioned were the new road signage costs and chloride roads.

M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to adjourn the meeting at 9:10 p.m.
