

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES
(Unapproved)
March 9, 2010

The annual Brunswick Township meeting was held in the Town of Brunswick, County of Kanabec, State of Minnesota on the 9th day of March, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Clerk Nelson; flag pledge was said and Dave DeVito was chosen as moderator.

OLD BUSINESS:

Gary Runquist requested that the posting of meeting minutes on the County website go faster. A motion by Ron Peterson; seconded by Gary Runquist:

- o As there is no limit on the number of elections in a given year, and
- o As the people noted in March, 2008 to change the General Election to November,
- o As the Town Board officials set November 2010 for the first November election passing over November 2008 and November 2009,
- o We hereby censure the Town Board officials for delaying the November voting and thereby extending their terms in office.

Vote was taken; motion failed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Donation Requests: Motion by Gary Runquist and seconded by Paul Kollar to donate \$ 400.00 to each organization represented. Motion carried.

2011 Tax Levy – The Board of Supervisors recommended to the residents a total levy of \$ 155,000. Motion by Jim Nelson and Paul Kollar to accept the Board recommendation of \$ 155,000. with Revenue of \$ 46,400; Road & Bridge of \$ 80,600; Fire of \$ 28,000. Ron Peterson requested to amend the motion to set the 2011 levy at \$ 125,000. Amendment failed for lack of second. A discussion was held on upcoming road projects. Motion carried.

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR:

A question was raised on the March 4th issue of Kanabec County Times regarding a tower being erected on land owned by Isanti County in SW corner of township and whether tower would be used for essential services. It is noted that the Board set a hearing on the proposed tower to be held in April.

A motion by Donna Kollar, seconded by Rod Wulfekuhle to adjourn the annual meeting at 9:45 p.m. Motion carried.
