


BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP RECONVENED ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES  
(Unapproved)  
September 8, 2008

The annual Brunswick Township meeting was reconvened in the Town of Brunswick, County of Kanabec, State of Minnesota on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by moderator Rick Kawalek; flag pledge was said. Rick stated the purpose of the meeting – continue March, 2008 Annual Meeting.

Portions of the minutes of the 2008 Annual Meeting were read by Clerk, Gladys Nelson. A report by the Board of Supervisors was given in regard to information received for the Groundhouse River road issue since the March meeting. Town Treasurer Arlett Mizer reported a total of \$ 3,375 was paid to consultant Richard Larsen. Paul summarized Richard Larsen's report – he did a good job; however the total cost of the project was higher than thought and the grants available were lower than projected. Paul has worked with Kelly Osterdyk of the Kanabec SWCD and costs to do rip-rap for 850 feet is approximately \$ 72,611; 400 feet is approximately \$ 39,336. Discussion was held on other solutions including raising the road bed four feet; abandon the road etc.

Motion by Ron Peterson, seconded by Jim Anderson to authorize the Board to vacate the road. Vote taken; motion was defeated. Motion by Paul Kollar and seconded by Craig Peterson not to levy any additional funds for this road project at this time; levy will stay as approved at March, 2008 annual meeting. Motion carried.
