

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, May 10, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Paul Kollar; Craig Peterson; Arlett Mizer; Gladys Nelson; absent, Susan Alderink. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said.

M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the agenda. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2010 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on April 30, 2010 of \$ 85,708.28. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the claims.

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR: None

OLD BUSINESS: Groundhouse River road project: M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson to accept low bid from D & M Excavating, Inc. and proceed with Groundhouse River project. This action taken based on letter from Kanabec Soil & Water Conservation District dated May 10, 2010 stating approval of cost share funding for 75% of the project. M/S/C by Kollar and Kawalek to proceed with application to Pokegama Lake Association for donation of \$ 3,850. for the Groundhouse River project.

NEW BUSINESS: Zoning Administrator had no activities to report.


Mahogany Street: Paul reported on conversation with Monte of First State Tire on discussion to place tires on the 1100 – 1200 section of Mahogany Street to help with flooding problems. Grass Lake Township supervisor was at meeting. Monte explained he would raise the road bed without widening road and thought the only cost to towns would be for the gravel needed for the top road bed. Monte will contact Dick Larson for his opinion; Grass Lake will contact DNR re: beaver dams between road and Highway 65. Monte is to come up with plan and bring to June meeting.

Paul reported on several vandalism activities on the road. Clerk to mail letter to Kadlec Excavating re: cleaning old culvert and ditch/slope seeding. Zoning Administrator to send letter to Wallace Johnson re: fence placed on road right-of-way and ask for removal by June 1 or Town will do at his expense; Johnson must place fence 33 feet from center of road. Zoning Administrator to contact Jeff Akkerman about his black dirt operation.

Annual Meeting donations: Clerk reported on information received at Spring Shortcourse on procedure for donations made at Annual Meeting; Clerk will do checking and report on statute guidelines and contracts needed at June meeting.

OK for Craig to attend emerald ash borer workshop. Decision on road ditch mowing to be done in June. Paul to contact Dave Blum about brush cutting.
