

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES

March 8, 2010

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, March 8, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Paul Kollar; Craig Peterson; Arlett Mizer; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said. A moment of silence was observed in the passing of former Supervisor, Tom Lindquist.

M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the agenda. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the minutes of the February 8, 2010 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on February 28, 2010 of \$ 93,290.69. M/S/C by Peterson and Kawalek to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to revise the levy split as approved in February. The new recommendation for annual meeting is: Revenue - \$ 46,400; Road - \$ 80,600; Fire - \$ 28,000. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the claims.

NEW BUSINESS: Susan reported two land use permits: Altman; Bruce Nehring. Susan also reported a Conditional Use Permit application received from Isanti County for a tower to be erected in the gravel pit on their property; public hearing date set for Monday, April 5th at 7 p.m.


Road Report – Paul reported there are funds available for rip-rap on the Groundhouse River; project is recommended by the Soil & Water Conservation office with our share costing about \$ 5,000. M/S/C by Kollar and Peterson for the Clerk to proceed on the quote process.

Paul reported on chloride costs for 1 mile length of 140th Avenue – total cost to be about \$10-12,000. Further discussion at April meeting after spring road check and evaluation of other needed road projects. The Clerk received the report from Kanabec County on the bridge inspection; Supervisors to inspect during spring road check to be held beginning at 4 p.m. on Monday, April 5th.

M/S/C by Kawalek and Peterson to approve the renewal of the Mora Fire Department protection agreement.

Discussion on Planning Commission members – M/S/C by Kawalek and Peterson to appoint Bryce Johnson with Rick Stromberg as alternate. Dave Devito was given permission to attend a zoning workshop in June.

M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to adjourn the meeting at 10:00 p.m.
