

**BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES**

NEW BUSINESS: Susan's report was reviewed; one land use permit issued to Judy Lanoue. OPERA Grant: Board asked the Clerk to contact Richard Larson and have him prepare an application and work with him as needed to submit by the September 14 deadline.

Clerk received a call from Steve Nelson (lives across from Crazy Ladies) inquiring if he could cut trees on the corner of King Road and Keystone Street. The Board asked Paul to contact him and work it out with insurance and permission of adjacent landowners.
