

**BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES**  
February 8, 2010

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, February 8, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Paul Kollar; Craig Peterson; Arlett Mizer; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said.
