Plantskydd

Deer Repellent – All natural Swedish animal repellent provides plants with up to 6 months of protection against browse damage. Works on conifers and broadleaf plants. One lb. powder concentrate will treat up to 200-300 plants 1 ft. high. One lb. granular shaker covers approx. 600 sq. ft.; protects against rabbits, squirrels, voles & small rodents.

TREE SHELTERS: Protects trees from sunscald, rodents, mower, deer browse, etc. Research shows can increase growth in the first two years. Shelters promote the build-up of moisture during drought. Easy to install.

TREE MATS: We recommend mats for weed control which is critical for the first 2-3 years. The mats also aid in moisture retention.

NATIVE FLOWER/GRASS SEED MIXTURES:

SHORT/DRY MIX: 1 oz./3 oz. mix covers 600 sq. ft. ideal in sandy or gravelly soils, along walkways/buildings where shorter vegetation is desirable (Height 1'3').

MIXED HEIGHT/MESIC MIXES: 1 oz./3oz. mix covers 600 sq. ft. suitable for most sites and a variety of soils (Height 2.5'-6').

⚡ These trees are not compatible with overhead electric distribution lines. Plant them **AT LEAST** 25 feet beyond the lines to allow for crown development and future reconstruction. **For more info contact East Central Energy at (866) 293-9068, or visit www.eastcentralenergy.com**
