

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP **APPROVED** MEETING MINUTES

May 11, 2009


The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, May 11, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Paul Kollar; Craig Peterson; Arlett Mizer; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink, absent. A sign-in sheet was provided for those attending the meeting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said.

M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the agenda. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2009 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on April 30, 2009 of \$ 110,371.68. M/S/C by Peterson and Kollar to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the claims.

**OLD BUSINESS: Road Project – Groundhouse River:** The Clerk received 4 quotes for the project – Ron Kadlec Excavating, \$ 29, 540.00; D & M Excavating, Inc., \$ 44,925.00; Hjort Excavating, Inc., \$ 44,720.00; Anderson Excavating, \$ 35, 452.25. (The Supervisors received the information for both projects prior to the meeting and a discussion of the quotes was held.) M/S/C by Kawalek and Peterson to accept the quote of Ron Kadlec Excavating of \$ 29,540.00. M/S/C by Kawalek and Peterson to have Attorney Kevin Hofstad prepare a contract for the Groundhouse River project.

**Road Project – Lumber Street:** The Clerk received 5 quotes for the project – Ron Kadlec Excavating, \$ 85,725.40; Hjort Excavating, Inc., \$ 93,780.74; Keith Visser, \$ 69, 860.60; Bill Jones Construction, \$ 63,601.00; KCR Construction, \$ 59,964.00; First State Tire cost of \$ 8,112.00 for placing tire shreds and wrapping. The Supervisors discussed the project further and asked questions of those present and talked of possibilities of grants and funding. It was felt this was a lot of \$'s for a short stretch of township road. M/S/C by Kawalek and Peterson to table a decision on the Lumber Street quotes for one month and have Paul contact Richard Larson etc. for funding for the project.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Supervisors reviewed and discussed Susan's report. M/S/C by Peterson and Kawalek to approve approximately 5000 yards of gravel for 2009. Board asked KCR to fix hole in culvert on Holly Trail near Eberly property and fix culvert on Debra Lane. The Board asked Susan to check on the location of corn planted in the ditch on road – 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue - going west of Hwy 65; and determine if a hazard. M/S/C by Kawalek and Kollar to approve the assessor contract with Kanabec County for year 2010 and 2011. M/S/C to adjourn the meeting at 9:50 pm.
