

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES

October 13, 2008

**Susan reported receipt of an application for a Conditional Use Permit by Kevin and Vikki Fore – Public Hearing set for November 5, 2008.

**Susan checked on the temporary permit on the Miller property – the trailer is still there but is currently being used for storage.

**Susan asked the Kanabec Shoreland to handle the Winkelman property where there are more houses than allowed.

**The Board asked Susan to write a letter to Wallace Johnson and ask him to move the fence on his property out of the road right-of-way.

Road Issues: Paul reported on the Devils Lake road. He met with Arthur Supervisor, Sawatzky, and discussed ruts in the road, ditch on west side and location of mail boxes. Paul to check with the Postmaster in Mora to see if mailboxes can be moved so they are all on one side.
