

There was discussion on an Interim Ordinance hearing and meeting – date will be set after MN Pollution Control Agency and Kanabec County Commissioners complete their findings and make a decision.

The Clerk will send an Information Request form to Attorney Carrie Doom for requested items on the Interim Ordinance prohibiting the use of shredded tires on private property passed by the Board of Supervisors on September 13, 2010.
