

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP **APPROVED** MEETING MINUTES

April 9, 2012

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, April 9, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Jeff Akkerman; Craig Peterson; Rick Kawalek; Shari Hartog; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said. A sign-in sheet was provided for all in attendance.

M/S/C unanimous by Kawalek and Peterson to approve the agenda. M/S/C unanimous by Peterson and Akkerman to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2012 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on March 31, 2012 of \$ 142,522.22. M/S/C unanimous by Peterson and Akkerman to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C unanimous by Akkerman and Kawalek to approve the claims (check numbers 6014 – 6024; total of claims \$ 5,473.53).

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR: Grass Lake Township Supervisors Donna Golly and Dan Kent were at the meeting. They expressed some concerns on the town line road (Mahogany Street) – road is narrow; culvert placed was not as described by Supervisor Paul Kollar; concern with safety if car were to go off road in that area because of the depth of the water. Brunswick Supervisors will check the area and review the concerns when on the spring road check.

OLD BUSINESS / ROAD ISSUES: Rick reported on a meeting with the other Townships on the Ogilvie fire contract. Gladys was asked to email Attorney Troy Gilchrist and obtain an estimate to draw up a new contract and report the information to the other townships. Rick requested a sample fire contract from MAT.

Complaint of road damage near 1938 - 130th Street (former Town Hall road). The Board asked Susan to stop over and talk to the land owners.

NEW BUSINESS: Zoning Administrator – Susan suggested drafting an “Affidavit of Attachment” for each of the parcels on Legend Street with the boundary problem (Coleman/Johnson) and recording them to their respective parcel; a copy of the recorded paper to be sent to Stuart Title and the property owners.


Susan received a complaint of excessive dust from the trucks taking dirt from the Leon Haines property; she will follow up with the trucker and landowner.

A quote for **2012 road work** was submitted by HP Gravel & Grading. The Supervisors reviewed the information. M/S/C unanimous by Akkerman and Kawalek to accept the quote and issue 3 separate contracts – snow removal; grading; gravel.

Spring Road Check will be held on Monday, April 16th starting at 4:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The Clerk was asked to place notices for 2012 mowing, spraying, tree removal, posting and notification; notice to be twice in the Kanabec Times and twice in the Mora Advertiser.

M/S/C unanimous by Peterson and Akkerman to allow Shari to attend the Summer Short Course.
