

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES

August 13, 2012

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, August 13, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Supervisor A, Jeff Akkerman; Supervisor B, Rick Kawalek; Supervisor C, Craig Peterson; Shari Hartog; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said. A sign-in sheet was provided for all in attendance.

M/S/C unanimous by Kawalek and Akkerman to approve the agenda. M/S/C unanimous by Peterson and Akkerman to approve the minutes of the July 9, 2012 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on July 31, 2012 of \$ 166,449.28. M/S/C unanimous by Peterson and Kawalek to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C unanimous by Kawalek and Akkerman to approve the claims (check numbers 6066 – 6076; total of claims \$ 33,441.35).

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR: Ron Peterson talked about the judge ruling on the tire shred hearing from the MN Pollution Control vs. Monte Niemi.

OLD BUSINESS / ROAD ISSUES:

Ogilvie Fire Contract - There were no meetings in the past month. Craig reported attending a meeting re: proposed new building to house the Ogilvie fire equipment; Ogilvie City Hall; social services and Timber Trails. This project will not happen in the near future.

Roads – The Lumber Street project is complete and looks good.

Town Hall Insurance Review – It was decided not to change the current coverage.

NEW BUSINESS:

Zoning Administrator – The Clerk received a resignation from Susan Alderink, who currently serves as Zoning Administrator. M/S/C unanimous by Akkerman and Peterson to accept Susan's resignation. All calls and concerns will be forwarded to Supervisor Akkerman until a replacement can be obtained. The Clerk to place an ad in the Mora Advertiser with a deadline for applications of September 1st.

Town Hall fuel - M/S/C unanimous by Kawalek and Akkerman to pre-buy 200 gallons of fuel and also to fill the tank in August at the current special rate of \$ 1.399 per gallon.

Property Lines – A discussion was held on the Town Hall property lines. The Neitzel property has been sold and a new survey completed by new owner. Clerk to contact MAT Attorney Kent Sulem for direction on how best for the Township to proceed on needed corrections that may be needed.
