**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** to approve the expenditure of \$18,000.00 as a retainer for Hitesman & Associates, PA to be drawn upon as work progresses, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this expenditure is contingent upon any unused portion of the retainer being returned to Kanabec County once the Kanabec County Board of Commissioners determine that the need for Hitesman & Associates, PA on these projects has ended.
