It was moved by Stan Cooper, and seconded by Tom Roeschlein, and **carried** unanimously to direct the County Coordinator to prepare a job description combining the positions of Clerical Worker and Computer Technician.

It was moved by Stan Cooper, and seconded by Dennis McNally, and **carried** unanimously to temporarily postpone the transfer of the Coordinator's Clerk to Assessor's Office.

**1:00pm** - Architect Bob Ogdahl met with the County Board to discuss matters concerning the courthouse renovation/expansion project.
