

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP APPROVED MEETING MINUTES
February 13, 2012

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday, February 13, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Jeff Akkerman; Craig Peterson; Rick Kawalek; Shari Hartog; Gladys Nelson; Susan Alderink, absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said. A sign-in sheet was provided for all in attendance

M/S/C by Kawalek and Peterson to approve the agenda. M/S/C by Peterson and Akkerman to approve the minutes of the January 9, 2012 meeting. The treasurer reported total funds available on January 31, 2012 of \$ 152,038.92. M/S/C by Peterson and Kawalek to approve the treasurer report. M/S/C by Akkerman and Peterson to approve the claims (check numbers 5990 - 6001).

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR: None

OLD BUSINESS / ROAD ISSUES: The Audit meeting has been re-scheduled for Monday, February 27th at 6:00 pm. More discussion on 2013 levy at March meeting. Rick contacted all current Planning Commission members and they are willing to serve another two years.

Road Projects considered:


- 1) Use the shoulder machine on all town roads - \$ 2500 - \$ 3000
- 2) Clean ditches – (Leifgren addition; Pearl Harbor corner; B. Arnold driveway; culvert at Schindeldecker) for estimated cost of \$ 6000 - \$ 7000
- 3) Dust control for another one mile - \$ 2500 plus gravel cost of approx. \$ 10,000
- 4) Tree removal in road ditches - \$ 3000
- 5) Weed spraying in ditches - \$ 4000

NEW BUSINESS: Zoning Administrator – Susan was absent but reported to the Clerk there were no land use permits issued the past month.

Allen Schnack, Southfork Township Supervisor, was present to discuss reviewing the Ogilvie Fire Department contract. Allen has met with Kanabec and Ann Lake Township also and they would like Brunswick Township to join them to hire an attorney to give an opinion on our contract. M/S/C by Akkerman and Peterson to approve up to \$ 200.00 for the Brunswick share of the costs for an opinion on current Ogilvie Fire contract and answer specific questions. Rick Kawalek will represent Brunswick Township at a group meeting prior to submission to an attorney for review.

CORRESPONDENCE: Clerk received a letter from Kanabec Hwy. Dept outlining the bridge inspection; Supervisors will review during spring road check.
