The Kanabec County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00am on Wednesday, June 13, 2001 pursuant to adjournment with the following Board Members present: Dennis Schulz, Stan Cooper, Kathi Ellis, Dennis McNally and Dave Ulstrom.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, and seconded by Kathi Ellis, and carried unanimously to approve the agenda as amended.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, seconded by Dennis McNally, and carried unanimously to approve the May 23, 2001 Minutes of the Kanabec County Board of Commissioners as corrected: on Resolution 7-05/23/01, Ulstrom was shown twice on the vote and McNally was not shown.

9:05am - Hospital Administrator Tom Kaufman met with the County Board to discuss matters concerning bids to remove buildings from county property.

It was moved by Dave Ulstrom, seconded by Kathi Ellis, and carried unanimously to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS the county board has received four bids for the demolition of the building commonly know as the Mora Motel as follows:
