BUSINESS FROM FLOOR: **Jac Engebretsen**, 1647 153rd Ave, Ogilvie, was present. Jac would like the Township help to collect money for cost of fence and survey between his property and that of Greg Carlson. The following is noted:

****survey of area done in January 2010; Greg Carlson purchased land from his father in October, 2009; March/April 2010 moved 600' fence; August 2010 received summons from Greg Carlson; Matter between Carlson and Engebretsen resolved in April, 2011; Engebretsen finished rest of fence after April, 2011**

Questions – 1) how can the town be involved between Engebretsen and Carlson and recoup money on fence and survey?


- 2) how can the town collect monies – property taxes or?
