June 14, 2000

The Kanabec County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00am on Wednesday, June 14, 2000 pursuant to adjournment with the following Board Members present: Tom Roeschlein, Dennis Schulz, Stan Cooper, Dennis McNally and Dave Ulstrom.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, and seconded by Dave Ulstrom, and carried unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.

It was moved by Dennis McNally, and seconded by Dennis Schulz, and **carried** unanimously to approve the May 24, 2000 Minutes of the Kanabec County Board of Commissioners as corrected.

9:05am - The proposed Solid Waste Fee Ordinance was considered. It was moved by Stan Cooper, and seconded by Dennis Schulz, and **carried** unanimously to table the issue until the June 21st board meeting.

It was moved by Dave Ulstrom, and seconded by Stan Cooper, and **carried** unanimously to approve the April 1, 2000 and June 3, 2000 minutes of the Knife Lake Improvement District and to pay the following claims from KLID funds:

11:00am - Bid announcement for Bituminous Seal Coat was read aloud by the board clerk. The single bid was opened, announced and taken for checking and tabulation. Bid announcement for Aggregate Base, Bituminous Surfacing and Shouldering was read aloud by the board clerk. The bids were opened, announced and taken for checking and tabulation.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, and seconded by Stan Cooper, and **carried** unanimously to award the grading bid on SAP 33-615-03 to the low bidder: Gladen Construction at \$941,616.70.

It was moved by Dennis McNally, and seconded by Dave Ulstrom, and **carried** unanimously to approve payment of \$111,012.23 to Landwehr Construction for bridge work in Southfork and Pomroy Townships.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, and seconded by Dave Ulstrom, and **carried** unanimously to approve the following resolution:

It was moved by Stan Cooper, and seconded by Dennis McNally, and **carried** unanimously to approve payment of up to \$500.00 for technical assistance in a Feed Lot Improvement Plan.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, and seconded by Dave Ulstrom, and **carried** unanimously to an updated Drug and Alcohol Testing Program Participation Agreement with the Minnesota Counties Insurance Trust.

Bituminous and Seal Coat Bids were brought back to the meeting following checking and tabulation.

It was moved by Dennis Schulz, and seconded by Dennis McNally, and **carried** unanimously to award the bid for Aggregate Base, Bituminous Surfacing and Shouldering to the low bidder: Baurely Bros at \$631,742.28.
