The board clerk read aloud the public notice:

The Kanabec County Board of Commissioners will, pursuant to §164.12, Minnesota Statutes, hold a public hearing on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2000 at 10:00am in the temporary board room, Room 102, in the Kanabec County Public Service Building, 905 E Forest Ave, Mora, MN to consider request to set an agreement for road maintenance between Hillman and Knife Lake Townships.
