

BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES
(Unapproved)
March 8, 2011

The annual meeting of the residents of Brunswick Township was held in the Town of Brunswick, County of Kanabec, State of Minnesota on the 8th day of March, 2011 at 8:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Clerk Nelson; flag pledge was said and Dave DeVito was chosen as moderator.

It is noted the moderator, Dave DeVito, and Town Clerk will sign the annual meeting minutes. The minutes of the 2010 Annual Meeting were read by Clerk, Gladys Nelson. A motion by Paul Kollar; seconded by Rick Kawalek to approve. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the amount of delinquent taxes due (County Auditor/Treasurer reported to Clerk the amount is \$ 19,483.12) and the balances of the funds. A motion by Dan Weidner, seconded by Paul Kollar to accept as read. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Denny McNally asked why the posting of meeting minutes on the County website is still slow.

NEW BUSINESS:

Donation Requests: Motion by Paul Kollar and seconded by Dan Weidner to donate \$ 400.00 to each organization represented. Motion carried. Motion by Ron Peterson, seconded by Shari Hartog to defer the decision for donation to Mora Fire Department to the Town Board. Motion carried.


2012 Tax Levy – The Board of Supervisors recommended to the residents a total levy of \$ 155,000. Motion by Jim Nelson and Paul Kollar to accept the Board recommendation of \$ 155,000. with Revenue of \$ 45,000; Road & Bridge of \$ 84,000; Fire of \$ 26,000. Motion by Ron Peterson seconded by Denny McNally to amend the motion to set the 2012 levy at \$ 125,000. Discussion was held. Vote taken on amendment: Yes votes were 3; No votes were 16; motion failed. Vote taken on original motion of 2012 levy to be \$ 155,000: Yes votes were 16; No votes were 3; motion carried.

BUSINESS FROM FLOOR:

Denny McNally asked the question about who makes rules, annual meeting directives and sets wages of elected officers. He also directed the Board to revise the land use permit application with more specifics. Motion by Denny McNally, seconded by Connie Kawalek to have the Board review the land use application form and add more detail. Vote taken: Yes votes were 12, No votes were 2, motion carried.

Ron Peterson – Motion by Ron Peterson, seconded by Jeanne McNally to request the board to proceed to find an attorney who is familiar with situations on use of shredded tires. This attorney is to write a letter to the Minnesota Attorney General to receive an opinion on the use and any research of shredded tires being used on private property. Discussion was held. Vote was taken: Yes votes were 4, No votes were 10; motion failed.

A motion by Paul Kollar, seconded by Donna Kollar to adjourn the annual meeting at 9:35 p.m. Motion carried.
