The Clerk received tapes of the election results for the General Election held in the Town of Brunswick, County of Kanabec, State of Minnesota on Tuesday, November 6, 2012.

*Rick Kawalek received 575 votes; blank and write-in votes of 153. Rick Kawalek was declared Supervisor B for the term of four years to fill the position of Rick Kawalek whose term expires.

**Craig Peterson received 575 votes; blank and write-in votes of 153. Craig Peterson was declared Supervisor C for the term of four years to fill the position of Craig Peterson whose term expires.

***Ron Peterson received 51 write-in votes; Gladys Nelson received 34 write-in votes; other write-in votes totaled 42; blank votes totaled 601 votes. Ron Peterson was declared Clerk for a four year term to fill the position of Gladys Nelson whose term expires.

TERM LENGTH is defined in MN Statute 367.03 subd. 4. Officers; November election. Supervisors and other town officers in towns that hold the town general election in November shall be elected for terms of four years commencing on the first Monday in January and until their successors are elected and qualified. The Clerk and Treasurer shall be elected in alternate years.

Total number of voters was 728. Election judges were – Judy Fredrickson; Sharon King; James Boster; Larry Thronson; Gladys Nelson; Judy Barnick; Shari Hartog; Jack Stephens; Sharon Steffen. A copy of the Summary Statement is filed at the Town Hall with other election result information.

A motion by Akkerman, seconded by Peterson to accept the summary statement as presented by the Clerk for the November 6, 2012 election. All voted, yes; motion carried. A motion by Akkerman, seconded by Peterson to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 p.m. Motion carried.
