

**MINUTES OF BRUNSWICK REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

- Clerk Peterson read the minutes of the regular board meeting of October 13, 2014.

- M/S/C by Akkerman that Treasurer's report of total cash available \$193,063.20 is filed for audit.
- M/S/C by Akkerman to pay the claims, Akkerman aye, C. Peterson aye, Kawalek aye.
- Steve Johnson reported 4 permits issued: Mike Held, 1437 MeadowLark LN., Mobile Home; Julie Asmussen, 1779 145<sup>th</sup> Ave., Pole Building; Loren Berg, 1367 King Rd, Garage; Ernest Smith, 1272 Garden St., Pole Shed.
- Clerk Peterson reported a letter from county coordinator requesting support for Border-to-Border broadband initiative. Board consensus is that there is insufficient information available to support the initiative.
- Clerk Peterson reported a letter from county coordinator requesting database of township Commercial or Industrial properties. Consensus is that information is available in county assessor's office.
