

BRUNSWICK TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES
OF
November 9, 2015

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday November 9, 2015 at 7 p.m. The following were in attendance: Rick Kawalek, Craig Peterson, Shari Hartog, Steve Johnson and Ron Peterson. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said.

- M/S/C by Kawalek to approve the agenda.
- Clerk Peterson read the minutes of the regular board meeting of October 12, 2015.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2015 regular board meeting.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson that Treasurer's report of total cash available \$234,707.41 is filed for audit.
- M/S/C by Akkerman to pay the claims, C. Peterson aye, Kawalek aye, Akkerman aye.
- Steve Johnson reported issuing two permits. One to Josh Nehring, 1844 145th Avenue for a residence and one to Jason Shockman, 2016 127th Avenue for a garage.
- Dennis McNally was present and discussed the Highway 65 Coalition meeting next on the 18th; that Kanabec County does not sell mailboxes – the county does install them when redoing a county road; and asked for clarification regarding maintaining the Rustic Road right-of-way. McNally said the neighbors had been prepared to clear some of the right-of-way, but cancelled their plans after seeing the advertised Request For Proposals to clear right-of-way. The supervisors agreed that the neighbors can do the clearing.
- Rod Minnich asked about the caution signs for Lumber Street and was assured that the signs were on order.
- Jeff Akkerman reported on putting up road signs, ordering the caution signs and the complaint about gravel missing.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to opt out of the Kanabec County Economic Authority.
- Consensus of the board is to join Arthur Township in purchasing calcium chloride for dust control.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to adjourn at 8:30 p.m.
