

# PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNTY BOARD

**September 8, 1999**

The Kanabec County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00am on Wednesday, August 11, 1999 pursuant to adjournment with the following Board Members present: Dennis McNally, Dave Ulstrom, Dennis Schulz, and Stan Cooper.

It was moved by Dennis McNally, seconded by Dave Ulstrom, and **carried** unanimously to approve the agenda as amended.

**9:05am** - County Surveyor Del Rude met with the County Board to discuss matters concerning the Surveyor Y2000 budget request. The board took the budget request under advisement.

It was moved by Dave Ulstrom, seconded by Dennis McNally, and **carried** unanimously to approve the August 25, 1999 Minutes of the Kanabec County Board of Commissioners as corrected.

**9:15am** - Michael Parent, Director of Development for the National Ataxia Foundation, met with the County Board to request a pulltab renewal.

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It was moved by Stan Cooper, seconded by Dennis McNally, and carried unanimously to pass the following resolution:

## **RESOLUTION 99-9/8-1**

**WHEREAS** the Kanabec County Board of Commissioners has been presented with a request for lawful gambling within Kanabec County, and

**WHEREAS** the application was complete, included all necessary documentation, appears in accordance with County Policies and the facility owners are in good standing with the County;

**BE IT RESOLVED** to approve the Premises Permit Application for Class B Gambling at Woodland Jack's Bar & Grill, 3603 Highway 65, Isle, MN 56342; gambling to be operated by National Ataxia Foundation, 2600 Fernbrook Lake, Suite 119, Plymouth, MN 55447.

**WHEREAS** Social Service Supervisor Pam Brumfield has submitted her resignation effective September 24, 1999, and

**WHEREAS** the board desires to refill this position;

**BE IT RESOLVED** to accept the resignation of Social Service Supervisor Pam Brumfield, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Board authorizes the Family Service Agency Director and the County Personnel Director to hire a Social Service Supervisor to refill the vacant position at Step A, Range 9 of the pay plan which is \$18.88 per hour,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the hours of work for this position be limited to those budgeted.

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**10:50am** - County Engineer Greg Nikodym met with the County Board to discuss matters concerning the Highway Department.

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It was moved by Dave Ulstrom, and seconded by Tom Roeschlein, and **carried** unanimously to pass the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION 99-9/8-5**

**WHEREAS**, Kanabec County Road Number 69 is included in the Kanabec County Highway System, and

**WHEREAS**, this segment was recently regraded and bituminous surfaced, and

**WHEREAS**, there is considerable development along this route, and

**WHEREAS**, the Kanabec County Board and the affected local community, as well as the general public, share a common concern for the safety of those people using this road segment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Minnesota Department of Transportation be requested to conduct a study for the purpose of determining the proper safe speed limit for CR No. 69 from CSAH No. 11 to 1.5 miles east.

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The budget of the Highway Department was discussed. The board took the budget request under advisement.

**10:35am** - Sheriff Ernie Blaisdell met with the County Board to discuss matters concerning the Sheriff's Office. The Board was presented with the proposed budget and wages of the County Sheriff. Following discussion and consideration of the proposed budget and wages, the Board took the budget request under advisement.

Proposed computer software was discussed at length. The subject was tabled for more information.
